24-hour prayer cycle for #RedWednesday

Ideas for a 24-hour prayer cycle at Church

You could offer the use of the parish church for 24 hours to pray for the success of #Red Wednesday, the work of Aid to the Church in Need and for the communities we serve.

• Below is an example of a timetable you could distribute to parishioners. It does not have to start at midnight, it could start at any suitable time and simply run for 24 hours from then.

Prayer time could take many forms:

- You could begin and end the prayer cycle with the Mass
- You could have the Blessed Sacrament exposed for the duration of the prayer cycle
- You could have materials available to assist parishioners in praying the Rosary
- You could have Bibles available also

- A time for reflection: "Be still, and know that I am God!" (Psalm 46:10 [RSV-CE])
